## GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: \$1,000

### PURPOSE

The Community Impact Mini Grants support short-term, community-driven projects that:

- Strengthen the capacity and effectiveness of local coalitions
- Engage youth in meaningful leadership and decision-making roles
- Support youth mental health and well-being by building protective factors
- Advance commercial nicotine prevention and broader health promotion strategies

***Up to 20 mini grants will be awarded at the award amount of \$1,000 per grant.***

### PRIORITY AREAS

Projects must address one of the following:

- Coalition capacity building
- Recreational tobacco prevention and succession
- Youth engagement
- Youth mental health

### ELIGIBILITY

Eligible applicants must be Kansas based and include:

- Nonprofit organizations
- Community coalitions
