Moving from Data to Action

Use this collaborative thinking tool with your team to strategically explore your county's health data and identify meaningful, actionable next steps to drive impact.

Identify Areas of Focus

Which measures stand out? Where could your community improve?

Interpret the Data Correctly

How is the data presented (rate, percentage, etc.)? How are the measures defined?

Put the Data in Context

What local factors could be influencing this measure? Who in your community is most impacted?

Identify Strategies

What policies, programs or initiatives could help make progress on the identified challenges?

Implement with Partners

What partners are already working in this area? Who could help champion this effort?
